The history of Pickleball started in 1965 in the state of Washington. It slowly moved across the country until it reached The Villages outside of Orlando Florida where it became extremely popular among older retired residents, and it grew rapidly after that. Today pickleball is the fastest growing sport in the country.

Pickleball at The Glades Golf and CC started in the summer of 2014 on the hard tennis courts across from the Pro Shop. Chalk was used to modify the tennis courts to the dimensions of a pickleball court. Glades residents enjoyed playing on the hard courts until we discovered that the hard courts could only be used as a tennis court or a parking lot. We had to look for another venue to play. We gathered at the East Naples pickleball courts. Here again we were not allowed to play exclusively with Glades residents, which was our preference but had to share the courts. So, again the search was on for another venue.

The process began with Dave Robinette and Debora Crist attending every Board of Directors meeting for 3 years and circulating Petitions to convince The Glades Board to approve pickleball as a new amenity at The Glades. The Board did approve the addition of 3 courts on a temporary basis on April 20, 2017. However, the Pines and Palmetto re-grass project was already underway and due to delays caused by Hurricane Irma we had to postpone the start of temporary courts until the fall of 2019. The first game was played on the temporary pickleball courts in December 2019.

Pickleball has become an extremely popular amenity at The Glades and has been accepted and played by all age groups, membership continues to grow. We currently have outgrown the 3 temporary courts with as many as 20 plus residents waiting their turn on the courts. We look forward to growing the sport even more in the future and moving from the temporary courts to new and improved permanent courts.
